ORDER:

In the reference 1st cited, the Selvam Educational and Charitable Trust, Vadakkangulam, Tirunelveli Kattabomman District has obtained Government Order from Health and Family Welfare (ME.II) Department, Secretariat, Chennai, Tamil Nadu to conduct **B.Pharm Degree** Course with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) candidates from the academic year 1993-1994.

2. In the reference 2nd cited, the University has granted the Provisional Affiliation order to S.A Raja Pharmacy College, Vadakangulam, Nellai Kattabomman Dist., for conducting the B.Pharm Degree Course with an annual intake of 50 seats from the Academic Year 1994-1995.

3. In the reference 3rd cited, Grant Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation has been issued for B.Pharm. Degree Course, for the academic year 2019-2020 to the said institution due to DTCP approval pending.

4. In the reference 4th cited, in the 277th Governing Council meeting held on 30.09.2020, vide resolution no. 4, resolved to grant CPA/CCPA for the academic year 2020-2021 to the said institution for B.Pharm. degree course.

5. In the reference 5th cited, the Principal, S.A Raja Pharmacy College, Vadakangulam, has requested, Permission for increase of intake from 50 to 60 seats in B.Pharm. degree course duly enclosing the PCI approval.

6. In the reference 6th cited, the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi (PCI) has granted approval for 60 seats for the academic year 2020-2021 to conduct B.Pharmacy degree course at S.A. Raja Pharmacy College, New Raja Nagar, Vadakangulam - 627 116, Tirunelveli Dist., Kattabomman, Tamil Nadu.

7. In the reference 7th cited, the institution has been informed to submit permission from the Government to enhance the seats in B.Pharmacy degree course.

8. In this connection, the institution filed W.P. No. 16124 in Hon'ble High Court of Madras, in the reference 8th cited, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras has passed a order dated 11.11.2020 passed in W. P. No. 16124 of 2020 by Hon'ble High Court of Madras and the operative portion of the Court order held as follows:

".....20. In view of the above discussion, this Court is of the considered view that the scheme framed under the Regulations by the Pharmacy Council of India does not contemplate any permission from the State Government after approval is granted by the Pharmacy Council of India for increase in intake either in the B.Pharm. or M.Pharm. course in an existing Institution and the University must necessarily act upon the approval and grant provisional affiliation to the Institution. This is the manner in which the Pharmacy Council of India has understood the Scheme framed under the Regulations and it is uniformly applied in all the States and therefore the Government of Tamil Nadu cannot give a different interpretation and meaning that the one that is given by the Pharmacy Council of India."

9. Based on the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, an inspection was conducted on 12.12.2020 by the Inspection Commission constituted by the University and the commission has submitted its report. Scrutiny of the inspection report indicates the institution has fulfilled the necessary requirements for the issue of Permission for increase of intake in B.Pharm. Degree Course.

10. In the pursuance of the above orders, the University grants Conditional Continuance of Provisional Affiliation to S.A Raja Pharmacy College, Vadakangulam, Nelloi Kattabomman Dist., for conducting B.Pharm Degree Course for the academic year 2020-2021 and Permission for increase of intake as indicated below subject to the usual conditions already intimated in the Provisional Affiliation orders of this University and pending submission of DTCP approval.
