PREAMBLE:

In the reference 1st cited, the Principal, S.A. Raja Pharmacy College, Vadakangulam - 637 116, Tirunelveli Dist., has requested to grant the Letter of Consent of Affiliation for the starting of Pharm.D course, submitting the copy of the Hon'ble High Court Order, dated 20.01.2021.

2. Based on the request of the Principal and Orders of the Hon'ble High Court, Madras, an inspection was conducted on 17.03.2021 to verify the infrastructural, teaching and other facilities available for the conduct of Pharm.D course. On scrutiny of the Inspection report, no specific adverse remark or objection was found. Consequently, Letter of Consent of Affiliation has been issued on 04.05.2021 for Pharm.D course as in the reference 2nd cited.

3. In the reference 3rd cited, the Chairman, S.A. Raja Pharmacy College, Vadakangulam - 637 116, Tirunelveli Dist., has requested for grant of Provisional Affiliation to start Pharm.D course along with the approval of the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi.

4. In the reference 4th cited, the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), New Delhi has granted approval to S.A. Raja Phramcy College, Vadakangulam – 637 116, Tirunelveli Dist., for the starting of Pharm.D course with an annual intake of 30 seats from the academic year 2021-2022.

5. In the reference 5th cited, an inspection was conducted on 17.07.2021 for grant of Provisional Affiliation and the Inspection Commission constituted has submitted its report. Scrutiny of the inspection report revealed, No specific adverse remark or objection was found.

6. In the reference 6th cited, the Resolution No. 19, of the 283rd Governing Council held on 27.08.2021 has resolved to grant the order of Provisional Affiliation to S.A. Raja Phramcy College, Vadakangulam – 637 116, Tirunelveli Dist., for the starting of Pharm.D course with an annual intake of 30 seats from the academic year 2021-2022 without insisting on the Government Order as per the Orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras.

ORDER:

Consequent to the compliance with the Order of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P. No. 16153 of 2020, dated: 20.01.2021, issue of the Letter of Consent of Affiliation, approval of Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi, University Inspection reports and the approval of the Governing Council, the University grants the Order of Provisional Affiliation to S.A. Raja Phramcy College, Vadakangulam – 637 116, Tirunelveli Dist., for the starting of Pharm.D course with an annual intake of 30 seats for the academic year 2021-2022, subject to pending approval of DTCP.

The Institution has not furnished the DTCP approval and shall arrange to obtain and submit the DTCP approval within 3 months to the University from the date of receipt of this Proceeding.

This order is granted subject to usual terms and conditions which are given in the Annexure.

Any other condition, which the University considers necessary to impose from time to time, should be followed.

ANNEXURE

The Provisional Affiliation is granted subject to the following conditions:

- i) The admission procedure as laid down in Govt. order, Health and Family Welfare (MCA1) Department should be followed strictly.
- ii) The candidates should have been admitted before the cut off date fixed for the academic year and they will be registered to take up their I Year Examination as per existing regulations.
- iii) There shall not be any admissions before the grant of Provisional Affiliation and after the cut-off date fixed for Pharm.D. course.
- iv) The Trust, should undertake to abide by the Provisions of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai, Act, 1987 (Tamil Nadu Act 37 of 1987) and by the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations and Rules of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University applicable to the Pharmacy Colleges framed from time to time

- v) The Trust should agree for the Inspection of the College by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University at any time according to the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations and Rules for Pharmacy College framed from time to time.
- vi) The Trust should abide the Statutes, Ordinances, regulations and Rules framed by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University on matters of syllabus, Examinations, Code of conduct, extracurricular activities, etc. According to the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations and Rules of the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University framed from time to time.
- vii) The conditions that may be prescribed by the Pharmacy Council of India, New Delhi shall also be fulfilled and the norms prescribed by the PCI, New Delhi should be strictly followed.
- viii) Only eligible candidates according to the regulations of this University shall be admitted to the Course. While making admissions, the Rule of Reservation of the Government of Tamil Nadu shall be adopted strictly.
- ix) The sanctioned strength for the course should not be exceeded beyond the sanctioned intake.
- x) There shall not be any financial Commitment either to this University or to the Government.
- xi) Hostel accommodation shall be made available for the students both Male and Female separately.
- xii) Furnishing of false information to the University on any matter or suppression of facts while furnishing information to the University or Violation of any of the Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations, Rules, instructions or conditions of affiliation shall result in withdrawal of the Affiliation of the College.
- xiii) The Institution shall have a duly constituted Governing Body with a representative of the teaching staff to advise the Principal in the affairs of the College. A record of proceedings of the said Governing Body of the College shall be maintained by the Principal. Any change in the Governing Body of the College shall be reported to the University immediately.
- xiv) The College shall furnish a "Utilisation Certificate" to the University stating that the interest accrued on the Security Deposit created with this University shall be utilised towards maintenance of the Pharmacy College.
- xv) The Governing Body of the College shall meet at least once in every three months to consider the Budget Estimates and such meeting if be conducted in May - June each year to consider the Annual Report of the audited statement of accounts, changes in the pattern of staff, subjects or courses in which fresh affiliation or approval is to be sought in the following year, etc. A Copy of approval notice of the meeting shall be sent to the Registrar, atleast 15 days before the date of the meeting. A copy of the minutes of the meeting shall also be sent to the Registrar of this University within 15 days from the date of the meeting.
- xvi) The College shall furnish a Budget for each year of study and a separate development budget which will cover the expenses for the fulfillment of the requirements prescribed for the subsequent year of study. The Provisional Affiliation now granted by the University is for the first year of the said degree Course.
- xvii) After fulfilling all the conditions required to be fulfilled by the college under the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University (Affiliation of Pharmacy Colleges) Statutes, by the end of the 1 year Pharm.D degree course of study, the institution shall apply to this University for the grant of Continuance of Provisional Affiliation for the second year Pharm.D. Course.

Any other conditions which the University considers necessary to impose from time to time should be followed.
